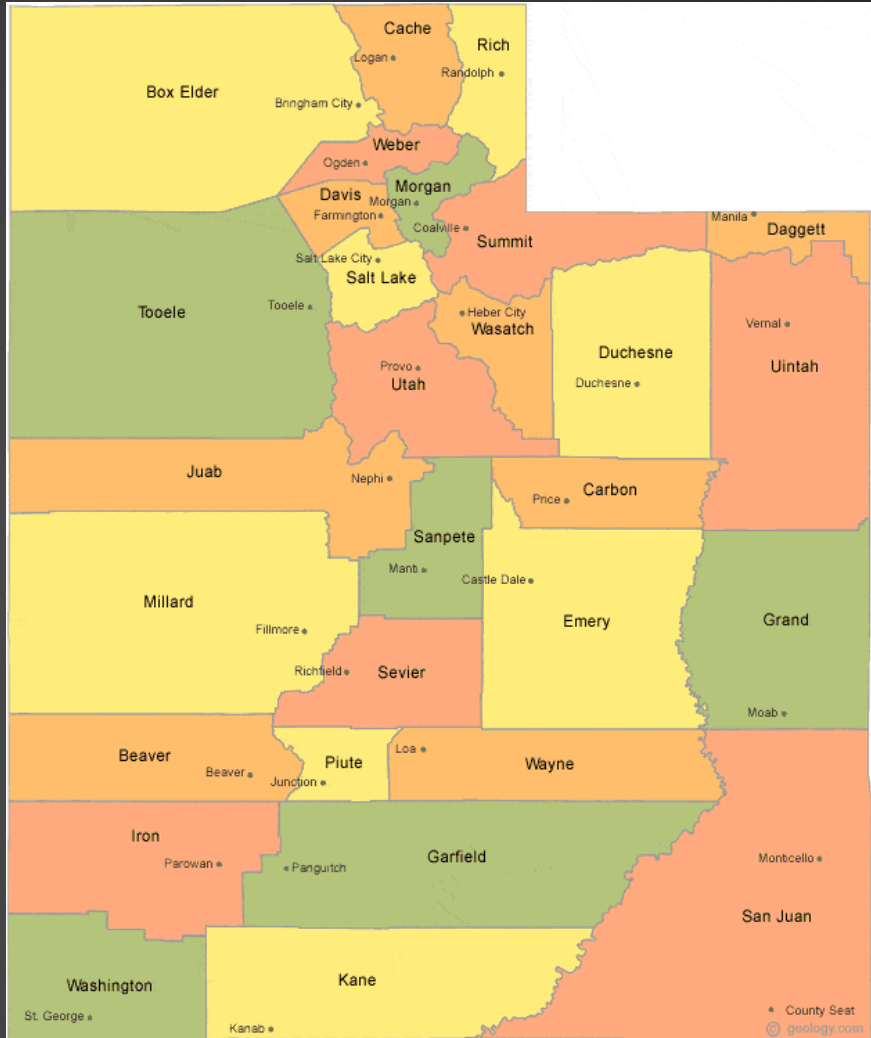

GRANT MANAGEMENT

➤ Purpose of Auditing:

- Assess compliance with Federal requirements
 - Match requirements
 - Non-supplanting
 - Nondiscrimination
 - 2 CFR §200
- Review of internal controls
- Ensure sufficient supporting documentation for costs
- Examine reports
- Provide technical assistance
