<b>Notes</b>	The Board reviewed the previous FACJJ survey and discussed revisions to the current FACJJ survey.
<b>Agenda Item</b>	<b>DMC Data Update</b>
<b>Notes</b>	<p>Cuong discussed the FY07 DMC Data Summary. The data is broken down by county and includes a (RRI) Relative Rate Index Compared with White Juveniles for each county. <b>Agenda Item</b>	<b>Juvenile Justice Specialist Report</b>
<b>Notes</b>	<p>All our monies are spent. Our FY 06 account has about \$8,000 left. The FY 05 and 05 supplement is zeroed out with the money allocated at our last meeting. FY 07 has approximately \$116,400 and needs to be spent by September 2009. There is about \$240,000 to allocate to new programs this year. We can boost that number with the remaining 07 funds.</p> <p>Reg submitted the JABG grant application, which will fund the same items as in the past. Please look at the Gang mini-grant RFP. Reg will post it on the website today. Funding</p>

	<p>of \$80,000 is available, up to \$20,000 per applicant.</p> <p>We may cancel the scheduled June meeting of June 27<sup>th</sup> and opt to meet earlier in the month so we can go over the grant proposals.</p> <p>The Title V solicitation came out yesterday for \$53,600 and is due by April 30.</p>
