Title V Continuation Project

Background: These grants are funded through the Title V Community Delinquency Prevention Grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. Only units of local government may receive funding for projects up to 36 months. Title V projects require a 50% cash or in-kind match of grant funds.

Delta City <i>Reconnecting Youth</i>	Model program serving 35-40 youth in grades 9-12 who show signs of poor school achievement. Integrates small group work and life skills training models in an after-school program. Also includes tutoring and vocational training.	\$37,800	2
City of South Salt Lake <i>Granite Park Youth Development</i>	After school program serving up to 300 youth focusing on strengthening community/school and peer/individual protective factors. Activities include: Gear Up After school Sports Program, Cultural Competency Training, Why Try Club, and student led services projects, social activities and initiatives.	\$47,025	1
