**2013 Goal and Objectives**

**Mission:**

Reduce the disproportionate representation of minority youth at decision points within the juvenile justice system from arrest through transfer and waiver to the adult system.

**Goal:**

Implement phase III (Intervention) of the OJJDP's DMC Reduction Model.

**Objectives:**

1. Continue to obtain and evaluate data on disproportionate minority contact in the juvenile justice system
2. Evaluate the Diversion Assessment Report and develop an intervention plans based on recommendations
  - Maintain diversion RRI in jurisdiction(s) where it reaches parity.
3. Evaluate 2012 DMC Arrest and Referral Assessment Report and provide technical assistance to develop intervention plans at local jurisdictions based on recommendations.
4. Market Community Relations training to law enforcement agency leaders and expand its use to current, veteran, and field training officers
5. Encourage juvenile justice organizations to use the Community Relations Curriculum offered by POST
6. Increase awareness of DMC issues among professional communities and provide updates to stakeholders.
7. Work with local DMC Working Groups to develop and implement intervention plans.
8. Participate in the 2013 CCJJ Commission Legislative Review meetings.
