

2017 PROGRESS UPDATE

- ✓ Continued data collection and RRI analysis
 - Completed FY16 RRI
 - Studied trends at arrest, referral, and diversion
- ✓ School Based Law Enforcement (SBLET) Training Update
 - Completed the SRO Manual/Curriculum (formerly known as the school based law enforcement training) in conjunction with Utah State Board of Education (USBE) as required by HB460, which passed during the 2016 General Legislative Session. The curriculum creates protocols and standardizes practices for School Resource Officers (SROs), and School Administrators (SAs) across jurisdictions on how to handle delinquent youth and determines whether to resolve the case at the school or to refer the case to the juvenile court
- ✓ Market Community Relations Training to law enforcement and expand its use
 - Supported the use of the developed Community Relations Curriculum for the Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST) to raise awareness of cultural diversity and teach cadets to work effectively with diverse communities. The training was provided to 749 firefighter and law enforcement cadets during 2017.
- ✓ Raised DMC Awareness
 - In 2017, DMC Coordinator presented to Chief Probation Officers and Weber County Sheriffs
- ✓ Participated in the 2017 Legislative Review; 158 bills were reviewed
