

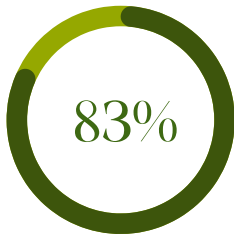


Fiscal Year 2022 Nonjudicial Adjustments Summary



FY 2022 Total

There were a total of 7,832 Nonjudicial Adjustments in FY 2022.



FY 2022 Success Rate***

83% of the total Nonjudicial Adjustments were successful, meaning they completed the terms of their agreement. (Increase of 4% from FY 2021).



FY 2018-2020 Recidivism Rate

About 19% of youth who entered into a Nonjudicial between FY 2018-2020, received a new petition before their agreement ended.

Agreement Options

- Fine, Fee, Restitution
- Victim Offender Mediation
- No Contact Condition
- Substance Abuse Screening
- Community Service
- Case Plan with Probation
- Educational Plan
- Truancy Mediation
- Alternative School Program
- Intervention based on criminogenic risk factors
- Other reasonable actions in the interest of the youth, community and the victim

An offer of a Nonjudicial is based on the offense type and risk level. If the youth declines or fails to substantially comply with the Nonjudicial Agreement, then the episode will be sent for Prosecutor review and may be petitioned.

*****This percentage incorporates successful, unsuccessful and no outcome (youth is still on a Nonjudicial).**

**The success rate is 91% if we only looked at unsuccessful vs. successful cases.
