## Calculating Overtime for Grant Project #2

## ABC Task Force Overtime Policy: based on 84 hours worked in a 14 day period;

Project 1/Agency 84 hours Project 2/Grant 6 hours 90 hours total

Of the 90 hours = 84 are paid at straight time and 6 are paid at time and a half based on the OT policy.

Straight Pay \$20.00 OT Pay —→ \$30.00  $$20 \times 1.5 = OT$ \$30.00

Of the 90 hours worked in the pay period 84 are paid at straight time = 84 x \$20 = \$1,680.00 Of the 90 hours worked in the pay period 6 are paid at time and a half rate =  $6 \times \$30 = \$180.00$ 

\$30 overtime rate is \$20 straight time and \$10 at half straight time.

6/90 = .067 time billed to grant

Officer A worked on the grant project for 6 hours. Officer A worked 6.7% of time on the grant project for the pay period

Only 6.7% of the overtime amount can be billed to the grant project.

6 hours x \$20 hourly wage = \$120  $.067 \times $60 = $4.02$ 

Of the \$180 overtime pay = \$120 in straight time and \$60 in the extra half time.

6 hours of straight time can be billed to the grant = \$120

Only \$4.02 of the \$60 of extra half time can be billed to the grant. \$55.98 of the \$60 extra half time is paid by the home agency.
